Orientation & Gear-Up Days

The ASB is the school organization that is responsible for all extra-curricular activities and many other things on campus. It is an organization which is operated by students, within the guidelines of the district and with the support of the Assistant Principal of Student Activities.

Services & Student Store

The ASB, aside from planning student activities, keeps trust funds for all campus clubs, runs the student store. All purchases made in the student store must be **cash** transactions. **Credit/Debit card** purchases must be made online through our Web Store at https://webstores.activenetwork.com/school-software/chula_vista_online_s/

All funds raised by the ASB go back DIRECTLY to students to support all student activities/athletics.

Web Store

For your convenience our Web Store will open starting July 10th. Parents and students who wish to use their **Debit** or **Credit** cards may do so by going to the CVH Web page and paying for their items on line. These items may be picked up during regular gear day hours posted in this mailer.

The Sammy Spartan Card (Optional)

Be one of the first 350 students to purchase this card and receive a limited edition 2017-18 spirit shirt. This card (formerly known as the ASB card) also allows CVH students to attend all home football and basketball games FREE except homecoming and CIF playoff games. The Sammy Spartan Card is \$30.00.

Student ID Cards

All Chula Vista High School students will be issued a student ID free of charge. Students must carry this card to school activities and while attending school. Students will not be able to check out books from the library or access the Internet without a student ID. A replacement fee of \$7.00, will be assessed for lost or stolen



ID cards. Replacement ID's are processed in the ASB Office.

9th Grade and NEW STUDENT Orientation

Step 1 — Report to the GYM at 8:00 AM.

Step 2 — Upon the completion of the orientation program, students will pick up their course selection card from the **PAC windows** (Follow the arrows to the PAC building). If you have not cleared residency, your will receive a form listing the items you need to clear before you will receive your course selection card.

Step 3 — After you have completed the above steps, you will stop by the Choir Room (1904) in the PAC to purchase or pick up (if you paid on line at the web store) your PE clothes, Sammy Spartan Card and yearbook. **CASH ONLY.** NO Debit/Credit Cards or Checks accepted in the Student Store.

Locker Assignments

This year Chula Vista High School is excited about rolling out a new on-line system for locker assignments. Students will be receiving information in their school email on how to sign up.

- This new system means that students will no longer have to wait in long lines to get their locker.
- Students will no longer depend on someone being available to assist them if they forgot their locker number or combination.
- Students will now have access to their locker information on line.
- **Students will simply go to the website online at: Cvh.lockergm.net** All of your locker information is only a click away.

As with any new system, there will be an adjustment period, but we are 100% committed to developing this process into the streamline, more efficient way of working with and maintaining locker assignments at CVHS.

Procedures

Step 1: Check your school email for instructions on how to sign up for c'locker online.

Step 2: Sign up online for a locker at Cvh.lockergm.net on the day your are assigned. See above.

Step 3: Read and Fill out the attached locker agreement form and have your parent/guardian sign it.

Step 4: Return your agreement on Gear Day to the ASB. **On gear day, if you return your agreement and bring a combination lock from home or purchase one from the ASB, an ASB student will open the locker you reserved online.**

Step 5: You must add your locker combination to the online system.

Maintain your locker by following the guidelines outlined in the locker agreement form. **We may not have enough lockers for every student so it is important to know that lockers are on a sign-up, first-come first-serve basis until they are all filled.
