

Free Eye Exam and Glasses

OneSight Vision Clinic in National City Chula Vista High School Day-November 1, 2018

This collaborative program with Luxottica International, the National City Host Lion's Club, the City of National City, National School District and other participating school districts in South San Diego County will provide free vision examinations and free glasses for 1,500 needy students.

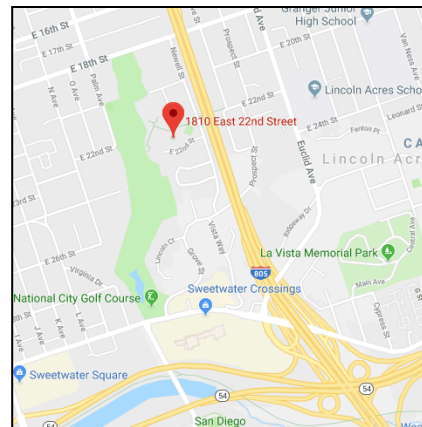
Each student will receive a comprehensive eye examination including visual acuity, color blindness, depth perception, muscle balance, tonometry, internal eye health through dilation, and autorefracton. If glasses are needed, they will be manufactured on site in EyeVan, a mobile manufacturing unit. Staff from Lenscrafters, Sears Optical, Sunglass Hut, Oakley and other Luxottica affiliates will manufacture and dispense new glasses to participating students.
